We are committed to keeping a close eye on any potential fraud on our members' accounts. When fraud is suspected (such as transactions from



your debit card that take place outside of your normal spending patterns), the typical procedure is to block the card and then follow up you via phone to determine if fraud has occurred. By not having updated contact information, you may experience the inconvenience of having your card blocked without knowing why, as well as being unaware of a potential identity thief.

If you've moved, changed your phone number, or updated your email address, please let us know in any of these ways:


Online Banking Users: Login to online banking, click on Settings, then Profile and select the address. Update and save.

MOBILE DEPOSIT

Making a deposit with your mobile banking app is quick, convenient, and secure.


After logging in, tap the "Deposit" button in the menu bar at the bottom of the screen. Tap "Deposit a check" from the deposit screen.





To begin, endorse the back of the check. Please remember to use the proper endorsement: "ForMobile deposit at TFCU Only" Choose your deposit account and enter the check amount. Tap "Take photos" to proceed.


Take a photo of the front and back of your check following the on screen instructions.





If you need assistance taking your photos, tap the question mark icon in the top right of your screen. This button will prompt you with instructions to get the best results for the images. The photo will be taken for you.

After taking the photos, tap the "Make deposit" button. This will confirm the check amount and the correct deposit account. You can check the status of your deposit at any time.
